

GRAYS HARBOR RACEWAY 2008 HORNET RULES

CAR CONSTRUCTION RULES

1. Any 4 cylinder car with a maximum of 103" Wheelbase and a complete stock STEEL Body, interior, and frame. OEM suspension and running gear only, **no modifications allowed**. **No** bracing anywhere except inside the drivers compartment. **No** rotary engine, turbo or four wheel drives allowed. **No** Camaros, Firebirds, convertibles, T-tops, or 4-cylinder Ford Fairmonts allowed.
2. Roll Bars mandatory: Either a standard 4 or 6 point cage , that is confined to the drivers compartment only, minimum 1 1/2" .090 steel tubing. Drivers door may be gutted to allow for door bars. Minimum three horizontal bars, contoured to door skin, 6" to 8" apart. Two vertical bars centered 12" between all horizontal door bars. A 1/8" steel plate is recommended covering the entire outside area of drivers door bars. Passenger door will have a minimum of two straight horizontal and vertical similar to drivers doors. Doors must be welded or chained shut. Maximum 1/2" thick reinforcement on the outside of the door skin on the right side. Left side, 2" maximum past door skin. Edges and corners must be smoothed and radiused.
3. Must have a minimum of a 5 point, 3" minimum safety harness, Window net mandatory, SEMI approved.
4. Dashboard, Interior, Steering, and Pedals must remain completely stock for make, model and year of car. All insulation under hood must be removed. All flammable material in the drivers compartment must be removed, the padded part of the dash may also be removed.
5. Car horns must remain intact and in working condition. Must have working radio and speakers in cars.
6. Stock carburetor or fuel injection for that make and model.
7. Transmission for that make and model.
8. Stock exhaust system for that make and model. MUFFLERS MANDATORY.
9. Battery may be relocated in the right front corner of the drivers compartment. Must be completely encased in a protective battery box. Battery Box must meet tech approval.
10. Stock unaltered rear end for that make and model.
11. Approved DOT 60 series or bigger passenger tires only. Wheels and tires must be of like size. No low profile type tires allowed, no snow tires allowed. No Nu-tread or racing style tires.
12. Gas Tank:
 - (a) If stock gas tank is ahead of rear axle it may remain in place. A fuel cell or plastic boat tank, (6.6 gallon maximum) is recommended. Subject to tech.
 - (b) If stock gas tank is behind the rear axle. It must be replaced with a fuel cell or a plastic boat tank (6.6 gallon maximum) is recommended. Subject to tech.
 - (c) Fuel cell/boat tanks must be covered, secured and located in trunk.
13. All glass (front windshield optional) must be removed prior to arrival at track. If front windshield is removed, it must be replaced by a safety screen that meets tech approval.
14. Third brake light **MUST** remain intact and in **WORKING** condition.
15. All drivers seats must be replaced with an approved racing seat. All drivers must meet all safety conditions including 2000 Snell approved racing helmet and a SFI approved fire suit in good condition (no holes). Nomex long underwear, foot, head sock and neck collars highly recommended. Drivers area roll bars must be padded.
16. Cars must be painted in a theme style.
17. Car numbers on doors **MUST** be at least 20" tall in an **EASY TO SEE** color. Roof numbers must be at least 36" in height.
18. \$400 Management claim in effect at all times. Claim does not include fuel cell or safety equipment.
19. No two way radio communication between driver and/or pit/grandstands.
20. Lineups are at the discretion of Track Officials.
21. All cars will register their number with Grays Harbor Raceway for \$40.00. All numbers are on a first come, first served basis. Contact the Raceway office at 360-482-4374.
22. Each car will draw for their starting spot for the heat and main event. Heats are 8 laps and mains are 15 laps. All races will be allowed up to one minute per lap to complete. Any car(s) that stop and create a yellow or red flag condition will be sent to the pits.
23. All competitors race for trophies only.
